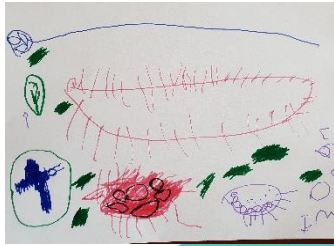

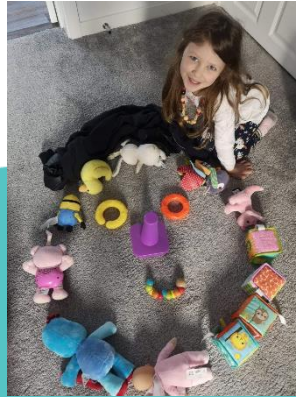

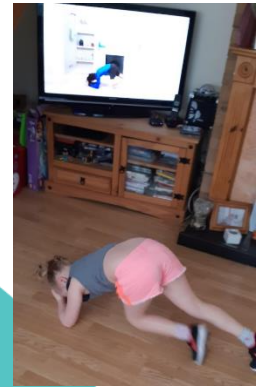
We have been trying to think of ways to make home learning easier, particularly for those families with more than one of our pupils at home. For this reason, we will now be planning along the same themes.

Lois created a great rainforest picture. Well done! (Y2)



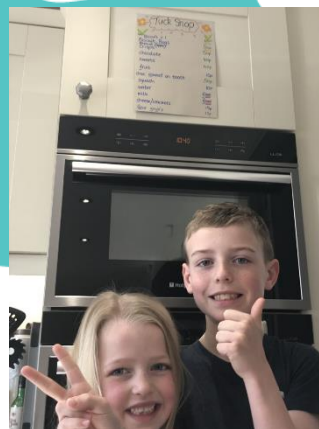
Jack (Rec) has been very busy painting in the garden. A lovely rainbow!
