### English

The children will be reading the text *Ocean Meets Sky*. They will go on to create their own fantasy story. After half term they will read *The Magic Finger* by Roald Dahl.

### Maths

The children will be continuing to develop their understanding of fractions, finding equivalents and counting up to a whole. They will also be learning to tell the time and learn how to read and draw pictograms and block graphs in our Statistics topic.

### Science

The children will complete units of work about growing healthy plants, life cycles and food chains.

### PSHE

This term the children will explore 'Health and Well-being'. They will learn about making healthy choices.

## Summer Term



### Design Technology

This term in DT, pupils will be developing their sewing skills as they make and sew a monster hand puppet.

### Computing

Using purple mash, they will learn how binary trees are used to answer questions. They will also complete an e-safety assessment which will inform their personalised e-safety learning.

### RE

This term the children will be learning about 'What is the good news Jesus brings?'.

### Art

### History
